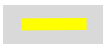

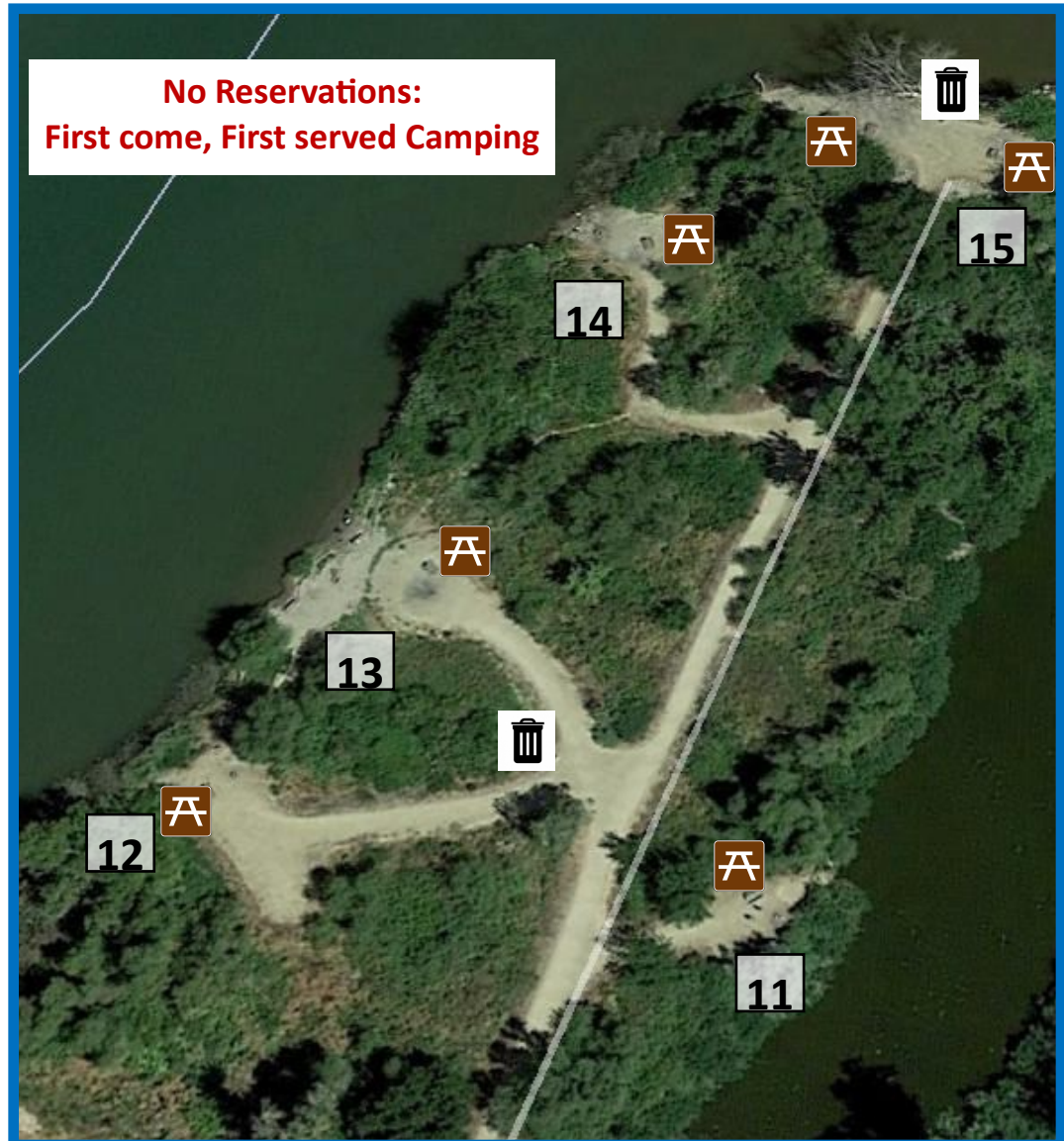

ABOUT:

Martin Landing is located at the confluence of the Boise, Owyhee and Snake Rivers. This recreational area is made possible through a cooperative agreement between Canyon County Parks, Cultural & Natural Resources and the Idaho Department of Fish and Game.

DIRECTIONS:

From Parma take S. Roswell Blvd. Turn onto Hexon Rd. Follow Hexon Rd. to Scott Pitt Rd. Follow Scott Pitt Rd. past Olson Ln. and take a right into the park.

NO Open Fires

Use Designated Fire Rings or BBQs.

Campfires may be prohibited during times of high wildfire danger.

CAMPING SEASON:

From approximately mid-November through March, Martin Landing is closed to camping. During this time, the camping area is closed to vehicle access. Walk-in access for day use, wildlife-viewing, and legal hunting and fishing activities is available year-round.

Seasonal camping is contingent on camp host availability.

CAMPING FEE AREA

- \$10 per night per campsite
- Make Checks Payable to :
 - ***Southwest Idaho RC&D***
- Please check in with Camp Host

Camping Maximum 3-Night Limit (consecutive in a seven day window)

QUIET HOURS:

10pm to 7am

During quiet hours, no generators or other motorized equipment emitting loud sounds or exhaust are permitted to be in operation

Camping Area is a posted:

- **SAFETY ZONE:**
- **NO DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN, ACROSS OR INTO POSTED AREAS**

DRY CAMPING: (Be prepared)

NO ELECTRICITY

NO POTABLE DRINKING WATER

VEHICLES

- No more than 2 vehicles per site.
- All vehicles must fit within the designated parking space.
- All vehicles must be registered.

No Day Use Fee

Day and night use for legal hunting and fishing are not subject to camping fees.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- To leave a vehicle and/or trailer unattended for more than 48 hours
- To operate vehicles off established roads
- To cut trees and or conduct clearing activities
- To use any form of fireworks or explosives
- To leave a fire unattended
- To discharge a firearm in close proximity to developed facilities
- To permit dogs to run at large
- To discard any trash or refuse
- To conduct any commercial activities except as specifically authorized by
 - The Idaho Department of Fish and Game
- Please be respectful of private property rights.
- Please do not feed or harass wildlife
