Dear Licensed Public Works Contractor:

We wish to update you regarding the solicitation for bids previously sent to you, dated November 12, 2019.

No objections to the specifications or bid procedures were received and no bids were timely received. After the time bids were due passed, Canyon County and its Department of Solid Waste received two (2) bids for the proposed project.

Because no bids were timely received, and only two received after the deadline, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") has determined that it is empowered by I.C. §67-2805(1)(e) to acquire this work in any manner it deems best from a qualified public works contractor quoting the lowest price. In this case, the lowest late bid of \$277,370.00 was submitted by Layne Christensen Company (a division of Granite Construction), a qualified public works contractor. The Board further believes that further competitive solicitation is impractical, disadvantageous, or unreasonable in light of the process just concluded. See I.C. § 67-2808(2)(viii). In light of these circumstances, the Board hereby gives notice of its intent to consider contracting with Layne Christensen Company for this project at its offered cost.

If anyone objects to this conclusion or process, please provide your objections to the Board in writing no later than 5:00 p.m., December 20, 2019, setting forth the basis of your objection and the further steps you believe the Board should take, and the Board will consider such objections.
