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SUMMARY NOTES

ONTRACTOR SHALL AT ALL TIMES COORDINATE HIS WORK WITH THAT OF OTHERS ON THE SITE. THE RACTOR SHALL HAVE A RESPONSIBLE PARTY WHO SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO REPRESENT AND ACT HE CONTRACTOR ON THE JOB SITE DURING ALL WORKING HOURS. NTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PERFORMING ALL WORK INDICATED IN THESE PLANS. ANY ITEM TED IN THESE PLANS, BUT NOT ITEMIZED IN THE BID SCHEDULE, WILL BE INCLUDED UNDER A BID SCHEDULE

O WHICH IT MOST PERTAINS. ONTRACTOR SHALL EXAMINE THE SITE, COMPARE IT WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, CAREFULLY NE ALL OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, AND SATISFY THEMSELVES AS TO THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH /ORK IS TO BE PERFORMED BEFORE ENTERING INTO CONTRACT. NO ALLOWANCE SHALL SUBSEQUENTLY BE ON BEHALF OF THE CONTRACTOR ON ACCOUNT OF AN ERROR ON HIS PART AND/OR HIS NEGLIGENCE

FAILURE TO ACQUAINT HIMSELF WITH THE CONDITIONS OF THE SITE. ONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT DIGLINE 72 HOURS PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION. 1-800-342-1585. ONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO THE EXISTING ASPHALT RIGHTS OF WAY. RETE, BUILDINGS, CULVERTS, ETC. DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT, AND SHALL REPAIR SUCH

E TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE OWNER, AT NO EXTRA COST TO THE OWNER. ATERIALS AND FINISHES SHALL BE AS PER DRAWINGS, DETAILS AND SPECIFICATIONS. SOME MATERIALS EQUIRE SEVERAL WEEK ORDER LEAD TIME. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING ANY AND ALL RING LEAD TIMES, AND PROVIDING REQUIRED MATERIALS AT THE PROJECT SITE IN A TIMELY MANNER. NO PROVED SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED. CONTACT THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT IMMEDIATELY IF A FIED MATERIAL IS NOT AVAILABLE.

ISTING CONDITIONS AND STRUCTURES, NOT SPECIFICALLY NOTED FOR REMOVAL, SHALL BE RETAINED AND CTED. EXISTING CONDITIONS AND STRUCTURES THAT ARE DAMAGED DURING THE COURSE OF RUCTIONS SHALL BE REPLACED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE OWNER. ONTRACTOR SHALL MAKE ARRANGEMENTS WITH UTILITY COMPANIES AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL COSTS CIATED FOR TEMPORARY UTILITIES NECESSARY DURING CONSTRUCTION. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE ALL UTILITY COSTS DURING CONSTRUCTION AND INCLUDING THE MAINTENANCE PERIOD. COSTS FOR RARY UTILITIES ARE A PART OF THE BASE BID.

ONTRACTORS WORKING WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY ARE REQUIRED TO SECURE A RIGHT-OF-WAY RUCTION PERMIT, AT LEAST 72 HOURS PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION. DNSTRUCTION IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY SHALL CONFORM TO THE LATEST EDITION OF THE ISPWC AND OVERNING AGENCY'S (NAMPA HIGHWAY DISTRICT) SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS. NO EXCEPTIONS TO STANDARDS WILL BE ALLOWED UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AND PREVIOUSLY APPROVED IN WRITING BY THE

RNING AGENCY. ONTRACTOR SHALL PERFORM ALL CLEARING AND SITE PREPARATION NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER ITION OF ALL WORK INDICATED ON THESE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS. ORK IS TO BE PERFORMED BY LICENSED CONTRACTORS AND EXPERIENCED WORKERS. RACTOR SHALL OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ALL PERMITS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, UNLESS RWISE NOTED.



IN VENT THE CONTRACTOR PROCEEDS WITH CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT OFFICIAL CLARIFICATION FROM THE R'S REPRESENTATIVE, HE SHALL BE LIABLE FOR THE COST OF CORRECTIVE WORK AND SHALL REPAIR OR STRUCT THE FAULTY WORK TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE AT NO ADDITIONAL TO THE OWNER.

NTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING. ERECTING AND MAINTAINING THE REQUIRED MATERIALS. MENT AND MANPOWER NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TRAFFIC CONTROL WITHIN THE PROJECT AND ON THE APPROACHES TO THE PROJECT. COORDINATE WITH OWNER AS NECESSARY INTRACTOR AGREES THAT IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED CONSTRUCTION PRACTICES. 

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




DEMOLITION PLAN LEGEND





EXISTING ASPHALT PAVING & HARDSCAPE DEMO AREA, SEE SHEETS D1.10 - D1.30




EXISTING LANDSCAPE AREA TO BE DEMOLISHED, SEE SHEETS D1.20


CALLOUT NOTES

- RETAIN AND PROTECT EXISTING VEHICLE SCALE.

- 4. REMOVE EXISTING BOLLARD.
