<u>Section I.A. General Project Requirements – Scope of Work Subsection 1. Warehouse</u>

Revised drawings will be issued for the Warehouse portion of this Project. The new drawings will modify the design of the Warehouse to include the following:

- 1. Additional 25x100 sq. foot storage bay for a total of 12,500 sq. feet for warehouse;
- 2. addition of a heated flooring system throughout warehouse; and
- 3. addition of an awning for outdoor storage on west side of building.

Written Questions

- **Q.1.** Page 2 of 13, 1. Warehouse, item e and Animal Shelter, item d: *CM/GC will be responsible for successful application for all necessary permits and required inspections.* Is there any information regarding what permits will be required and what the timeframe will be to get the applications reviewed and permitted?
- **A.1.** The time frame will determine on when the CM/GC will pick a pre-engineered metal building and work with the architect for structural design and then submit for permits with the City of Caldwell.
- Q.2. Page 2 of 13, 2. Animal Shelter, item b: Modification of mechanical and electrical systems are included in the scope of the work. Could you please clarify this statement? Are these existing or new systems? Have the modifications been designed by the Engineer?
- **A.2.** The mechanical and electrical systems for the Animal Shelter are existing, but will likely require some modifications. Yes, modification are designed by engineers. The County has a stamped sent of plans.
- Q.3. What sections need to be initialed in order to be in compliance with the requirement of Section V RFQ Checklist & Review Criteria?
- **A.3.** RFQ sections requiring a response pursuant to **Section V.** are found on pages 11-12 of the RFQ.
- Q.4. Is Attachment C to the RFQ leftover from the Fair Expo project and is this something that should be completed by proposers in this project?
- **A.4.** Any reference in Attachment C to "Design/Build" should be consider "CM/GC". Those references and the reference to the "Fair Expo Building project" are ministerial errors. <u>Attachment</u> C is fully replaced by Attachment 1 of this Addendum to correct this ministerial error.
- Q.5. During the walkthrough, it was discussed that the roofing in the kennel wings would be done in phases. Has there been any thought as to how those areas would be phased? And how many phases there would be?
- **A.5.** The County's intention is to complete the work in two phases. The first phase will be the 2 smaller back holding kennels. The second phase will be the main adoption holding kennel.
