

RESOLUTION NO. 23-143

A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE TO THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE CANYON COUNTY WEED AND PEST DEPARTMENT

The following resolution and order was considered and adopted by the Canyon County, Idaho Board of Commissioners (“Board”) on this 30th day of May, 2023.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Van Boeck and the second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board authority “to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government”; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-807 authorizes the Board to manage county property subject to restrictions including, but not limited to, those described in Idaho Code § 31-808; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-870(1) authorized the Board to “...impose and collect fees for those services provided by the county which would otherwise be funded by ad valorem tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §§ 31-870(1) and 63-1311 require that the fees imposed and collected by the County must be reasonably related, and not exceed, the actual cost of the services being rendered; and

WHEREAS, the Canyon County Weed and Pest Department proposes the adoption of the revised fee schedule attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated by reference.


