

DECLARATION AND NOTICE OF SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT

Pursuant to Idaho Code Section 67-2808, Canyon County hereby provides notice that it intends to obtain by sole source procurement new customized swine pen equipment from WW Livestock Systems for use at the Canyon County Fair.




The Board of County Commissioners declares that there is only one vendor of this product reasonably available and that further competitive solicitation appears to be impractical, disadvantageous, or unreasonable under the circumstances. In order to maintain value and functionality, it is paramount that the new pens be entirely compatible with the existing swine/sheep/goat show ring (also by WW Livestock Systems) in terms of material, design flexibility, and interconnectivity.

The Board intends to consider executing this purchase after taking comment on the record on March 12, 2024 in the Commissioners' meeting room located on the first floor of the Canyon County Courthouse, 1115 Albany Street, Caldwell, ID, 83605. Written comments regarding such sole source procurement may be directed to the Board at that address as well.
