



Operational Plan for The Wild Oak Venue

Introduction:

The Wild Oak Venue is a proposed wedding venue located in Caldwell, designed to provide couples with a picturesque and customizable setting for their special day. Additional Comments:	The applicant discussed with SWDH the proposal for a reception event center at 19871 Middleton Rd, Caldwell, ID 83605. There is currently a 3-bedroom house on the property with an existing septic system. The applicant is proposing a maximum of 300 patrons and 10 staff members with 100 events per year. May need to be a Public Water System due to the number of patrons and staff. The existing system will NOT be large enough to support the wastewater flows generated by the event center. The applicant will need to submit a site evaluation/septic permit application and provide a letter of intended use prior to scheduling and conducting test holes on site. Property is NOT in a designed Nitrate Priority Area. There are two (2) irrigation canals that must meet 50 foot horizontal separation distance to primary and replacement drainfield(s).
