**STARTING JULY 1 CAMPFIRE BAN ISSUED FOR CELEBRATION PARK DUE TO FIRE DANGER**

CALDWELL, ID — (June 28, 2024) The Canyon County Parks, Cultural & Natural Resources Department Director Nichole Schwend has announced today that campfires will be prohibited at Celebration Park beginning Monday, July 1st, 2024.

Fires outside the designated fire pits, including in portable fire pits, will also be prohibited. In addition, no pallet fires, rock ring fires, or charcoal grills will be allowed. Propane camp stoves for cooking will still be allowed while the burn ban is in effect.

The fire danger at Martin Landing remains extreme, so visitors are asked to please adhere to the campfire ban to help protect Celebration Park and the surrounding areas.
