 - Reducing the amount of time people are down range walking will help reduce waiting time to shoot and allow more people to recreate
 - Consider shorter lanes for pistol shooters 10-25-yard lanes
 - Granular rubber backstop for the backs of berms to remove ricochet
 - Introduce sound absorbing features
 - Identify what type of lanes we want
 - Short/Medium/Long distance
 - The Sheriff's Department side would be completely different than the Public Gun Range and be geared towards combat style
 - Consider looking into sponsorship
