- Discussion continued from August 22nd related to Gun Range design and plans
- Anthony with Kimley>>>Horn was able to display his screen through zoom showing live Auto CAD drawings of the public and sheriff's range design

- By the end of the meeting the advisory board was able to come up with parameters for Kimley>>>Horn and TRS
 - Suggestions we made included having 17 ranges with 4-5 shooting lanes per range so TRS could come up with an estimated cost for public range build out
- Kerry mentioned when it comes to gun range cost one 50-yard range equals the cost of five 10-yard ranges
- When it comes to lead issues make sure dirt/berm material stays within Range footprint and does not get moved outside of range footprint
- Anthony discussed the drainage system that would need to be built to prevent runoff
- Where do we place the extra dirt that exists in berm material?
