

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

2025 GRANT AWARDS

The Canyon County Historic Preservation Commission (HPC), under the direction of the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC), recommends and administers the Canyon County Historic Preservation Grant Award Program. The program grants funds to non-profit organizations in Canyon County dedicated to the protection and maintenance of historic materials or properties. To do this, Canyon County sets aside a small portion (*no more than twelve one-thousandth of a percent or $\leq .012\%$*) of property tax revenue every year.

**This April, the HPC received nearly \$140,000 in funding requests.
The projects below were selected for funding in the 2025 fiscal year.**



AMERICAN LEGION POST 18

Grant to repair main hall and restore stage of American Legion Post 18 building in Nampa.

TOTAL AWARD: \$39,700

Both listed on the National Register of Historic Places, these structures need urgent repairs.

NAMPA VALLEY GRANGE

Grant to begin restoration of the Nampa Valley Grange 131 building, including replacing shingles, roof work, and more.

TOTAL AWARD: \$37,000
