- New construction (typically limited to \$10,000)
 - Such as: sidewalks, storage, awnings, fencing, paint, floor installation and refinishing, parking lot repairs, lighting, insulation, permitting fees, electrical repairs, ventilation system, ADA accessibility, code compliance fixes, climate control systems, emergency egress stairways, gutter repair
- Furnishing
 - Tables, chairs, cabinets, racks, shelves, bleachers
- Electronic equipment and software
- Security equipment and upgrades
