SHERIFF'S SALE REQUIREMENTS FOR REAL PROPERTY

Updated 10/29/25

1. Required Documents:

Signed Letter of Instruction to the Sheriff indicating the interested parties to receive the recorded documents and Notice of Sheriff's Sale.

Writ of Execution: original or electronically filed copy.

Certified Judgment

Certified Order; Judgment and Order may be together, or included (stapled to)

the Writ.

Notice of Levy Notice of Sale

2. Check payable to the Sheriff's Office for \$1000.00 (minimum deposit).

Our advance fee of \$244.00 is included in the deposit.

Publication Fees vary (additional fees may apply).

Any remaining funds will go back to your office after the sale is completed.

Sheriff's fee is non-refundable once the sale has been set.

3. Check payable to the Canyon County Recorder's Office.

\$10.00 for the first page of each document.

\$3.00 for each additional page.

Per Idaho Code 8-506 (1), (2) the Writ and Notice of Levy must be recorded.

Once the documents are recorded, we will send an e-mail to you confirming the sale date and requesting a digital copy of the Notice of Sheriff's Sale for Posting and Publication purposes.

The legal description and physical address <u>must be</u> included in the Notice of Sale, as well as the redemption period.
