Indirectly related to Historic Preservation:

- Mechanical upgrades
- Museum improvements
- New construction*** (typically limited to \$10,000)
 - Sidewalks, storage, awnings, stadium seating, fencing, paint, floor installation and refinishing, parking lot repairs, HVAC, lighting, insulation, permitting fees, electrical repairs, ventilation system, ADA accessibility, code compliance fixes, climate control systems, emergency egress stairways, gutter repair

- Electronic equipment and software
- Security equipment and upgrades
